What's Available in Brantford

Woodview offers a range of services designed to meet children and families where they are.

Mental Health Supports

For children and youth experiencing challenges such as anxiety, mood changes, behaviour concerns, school difficulties, and peer or family challenges.

Programs may include:

- Counselling Services
- Brief Services
- Day Treatment
- Intensive Services
- SNAP® Programs
- Respite Support
- Youth Hub

Many of our mental health services are fully funded and available at no cost. Fee-for-service options are also available.

Autism Supports

Woodview offers individualized services that help children and youth build skills, confidence, and independence alongside their families.

Programs may include:

- Centre-Based ABA Services
- Family Skill Development
- Social Skills Groups
- Community Sessions
